For High School Seniors: Scholarships totaling \$25,000 are available to graduating seniors from the South Pasadena Chinese-American Club (SPCC). Two \$10,000 scholarships, named in memory of long-time SPCC Board Member Jojoe Zee, will be awarded to seniors meeting the following criteria: financial need, a GPA of at least 3.20, admission to an accredited college or university, legal status in the U.S., strong leadership, and participation in school, community, or volunteer service and extracurricular activities. Two \$2,000 scholarships, named in memory of SPCC Co-Founder Dr. Karl J. Hwang, are available to seniors with at least a 3.5 GPA who will be attending an accredited four-year college or university in the fall. Two \$500 scholarships will be awarded to students enrolled in a SPHS Chinese-language class for a minimum of one year who can demonstrate exceptional progress in learning the language.
